In 1997 the Seikatsu Club Coop and the Tokyo Electric Power Company started a collaboration named "The Monitorial Business of the Photovoltaic Energy". The purpose

was to make the Photovoltaic Energy popular in the metropolitan area. We gathered data of amount of consumption, and amount of generation which depend on geographical characteristic, daylight hours, and on direction, inclination, material of roof and so on at 132 cases in Tokyo and Kanagawa. The detailed data acquisition over 3 years was the first one in Japan and became rare, and valuable in the world. After the Monitorial Business, we renamed ourselves CELC(Clean Energy Life Club). With those data that have been stored, our members continue the activity. We independently gather data once per a month. On the other hand, we have to do a follow-up survey of device being used at each home and consider the influence on the environment in scrapping them. We aim at a Clean Energy Society by sharing information with the other organization and popularization activity.
